History of Chemistry (Day) Week

- ACS President George Pimentel proposed in 1986.
- Primary Purpose
 - To Communicate the benefits of Chemistry
 - To respond to apprehensions about chemical risks

Board approved

- \$100k funding from Society Reserves
- New office with one full time and one part time person
- Joint Resolution HJRes 265 introduced by Rep Doug Walgren (D PA) in May 87 to designate Natl. Chem. Day.
- Approx. 164 out of then 182 ACS Sections signed on.

- Tom emphasized early & often
- For convenience, meetings were at Tom and Dorothy's home in Skokie.
- Dorothy supported the work with donuts, coffee, and her time and space.
- Usually 7 to 12 attended & all participated.
- Site selection was generally done before May, sometimes while the previous event was underway.

Planning Meetings for 2006

- March 18 Summary of last event DePaul & discussion of nine possible sites. 7 People
- April 15 Narrowed site choices& discussed: Boy Scout MB sites; National materials; Speakers; Exhibitors; Student volunteers; possible PR choices.
- May 6 Discussed: Sites; Contests; Speakers;
 Demonstrations; & Individual assignments.
- June 3 Columbia College site discussed with details that need work.

Planning meetings 2006

- July 1 Site details are firm. Activities details & coordinators set. Boy Scouts ready. PR ok. Speakers ready. LSA/NCW teleconf 7/13.
- August 26, Site, Scouts, Speakers, Exhibitors are all ready. PR, Demonstrations, Flyer, & Finale are still unfinished.
- Sept 16 Mostly on Flyer, Floor plans, Assignments, etc
- October 14 Final details of assignments, etc.

Planned 28 October Celebration

- On October 26 major fire in building across the street from Columbia.
- October 27 All streets blocked off with unsafe buildings& we had no backup plan.
- October 27 After counsulting with Tom & the whole committee, we cancelled the event. We considered moving one week later, but it would still require another site.
- Only cancellation in 23 years.

Celebration at DePaul October 15, 2005

- The usual 8 planning meetings at Tom & Dorothys' home & two meetings at DePaul
- Lovely event held without incident.
- We counted: 750 students; ~200 adults;
 15 exhibitor groups (24 people); 100
 volunteers-many ACS members and affiliates; 17 HS teachers at workshop; 14
 B.Scouts; 14 HS teacher demonstrators gave outstanding finale; and 4 speakers.


